POLLING METHODOLOGY

The American Action Forum released individual and a regional compelation polls. The polling was conducted August 16-21, 2010 with 3,600 likely general election voters – 400 voters each in IA 03, IN 02, MI 07, MO 03, OH 01, OH 13, OH 15, OH 16, and WI 08. All respondents were selected randomly from a list of registered voters in the districts, and indicated they are likely to vote in the elections for Congress this fall, and interviews were conducted by live interviewers.
