Today the American Action Forum (@AAF) released a new infographic examining the economic impact of the State Sponsored Visa Pilot Program. 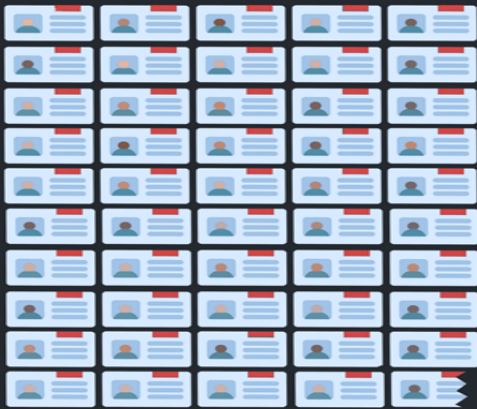


THE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF STATE-SPONSORED WORK VISAS
